CT ABDOMEN & PELVIS

INDICATION: Age: 75 years old; Male, "rectal cancer for staging"

TECHNIQUE: Routine portal venous phase contrast-enhanced evaluation. Oral contrast was not given.

COMPARISON: No relevant prior.

HEPATOBILIARY SYSTEM:

Liver: Mild fatty infiltration of the liver is suspected. No suspicious liver lesions.

Biliary Tree: No important gallbladder abnormality. No important abnormality of the biliary tree.

Pancreas: No important abnormality.

GASTROINTESTINAL TRACT: Rectal tumor is noted without invasion of adjacent organs or obstruction. MRI is best for local

staging.

GENITOURINARY SYSTEM:

Adrenals: No important abnormality.

Kidneys / Ureters: No important abnormality. Urinary Bladder: No important abnormality.

Reproductive Organs: No important abnormality of the prostate.

LYMPHATIC SYSTEM: Well-defined nodule adjacent to the posterior spleen is noted measuring 12 mm in keeping with benign splenule. No splenomegaly. No lymph node enlargement in the abdomen or pelvis.

PERITONEUM, RETROPERITONEUM & MESENTERY: No ascites or nodular peritoneal disease.

VESSELS & OTHER: Aorta is mildly atherosclerotic without aneurysm or major vessel occlusion. Portal and systemic veins are patent.

BONES / BODY WALL: No important bony abnormality. Fat-containing left inguinal hernia.

LOWER THORAX (lung bases, heart): CT chest reported separately.
