my whole life long.



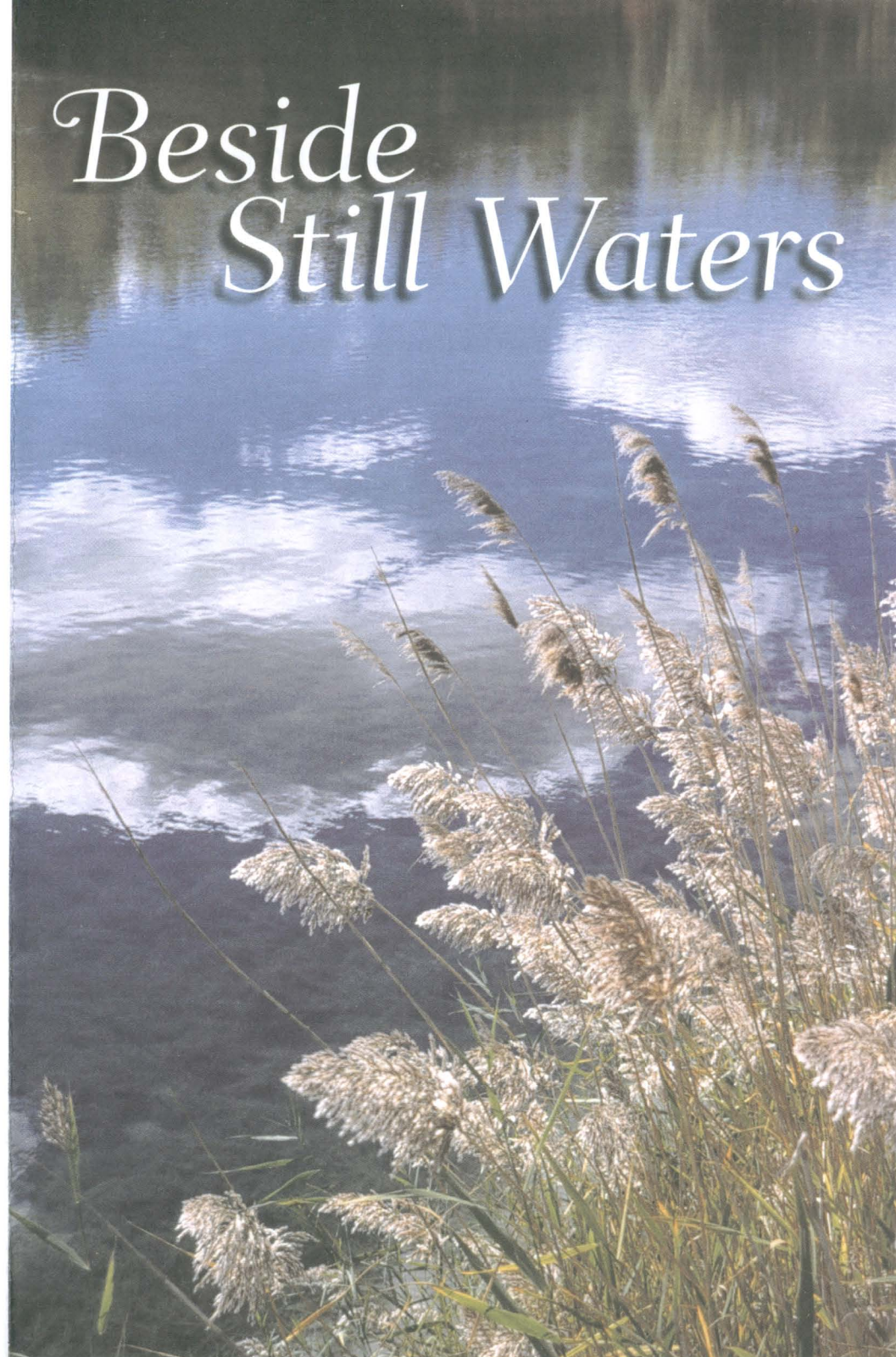
